In 1907, Henry Ford bought 160 acres just north of Manchester Street between Woodward Avenue and Oakland Street to build a car factory. Construction of the Ford factory in Highland Park was completed in 1909, and the area's population increased dramatically in 1913, when Henry Ford opened the factory's first assembly line. Over the past 12 months, homes in Highland Park have surged in value, with an influx of young couples buying and renovating homes in the immediate area. 





